## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing will be held before the Slaughterville Planning and Zoning Commission at Slaughterville Town Hall located at 10701 US 77, Slaughterville, Oklahoma at 7:00 p.m. on September 8, 2020. At that time, the Planning and Zoning Commission will consider an application submitted by Andrew Green for a proposed Use and Structure Permitted on Review for a medical marijuana growing facility on a tract of land in an AR-2 Agricultural/Residential High Density, Planning Area B. The property is located approximately four-tenths (4/10) of a mile east of 84th Street on Towering Oaks Drive (south side), at 8800 Towering Oaks in Slaughterville, Oklahoma.

Legal Description: Part of the North (N/2) of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township Eight (8), North Range One (1) West, of the Indian Meridian, Cleveland County, State of Oklahoma, according to the U.S. Government Survey thereof, and being more particularly described as follows beginning at a point 1980.00 feet East and 660.00 feet Sought of the Northwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter; then North 89 degrees 12'35" East, a distance of 658.24 feet; thence South 89 degrees 07' 27" West, a distance of 658.24 feet; thence due North 328.00 feet to the point of beginning, less and except the North 50.00 feet which is reserved for road purposes. A/k/a 8800 Towering Oaks, Noble, OK 73068.

The purpose of the application is for a use and structure permitted on review to grow medical marijuana as allowed by state law.

The Slaughterville Planning and Zoning Commission will review the application, prepare a report and make a recommendation to the Town Board of Trustees. Town Board of Trustees will hold a public hearing at Slaughterville Town Hall, located at 10701 US 77, Slaughterville, Oklahoma, at 7:00 p.m. on September 8, 2020 to consider the requested Use and Structure Permitted on Review.
